

# NOTICE OF RACE FOR I.S.C.Y.R.A EVENTS

## Star District 6 Championships Shilshole Bay, Corinthian YC August 10 & 11, 2019

### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR). The Organizing Authority is Corinthian Yacht Club in conjunction with the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA). The host fleet is Puget Sound Star Fleet.

- 1.2 The prescriptions of US Sailing to rules 40, 67, 70.5(a) and 76.1 will apply and will be included in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 RRS 32 will be changed to provide that courses will not be shortened.
- 1.4 RRS 33b will not apply.
- 1.5 RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 60 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- 1.6 RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- 1.7 RRS A4.1 will be changed to provide that a boat failing to check in prior to the warning signal will be scored the same as a boat not starting in that race without a hearing.
- 1.8 The amendment to STCR 31.2.6 (ISCYRA Resolution #4-2016) is in effect. Boats may carry VHF radios for the purposes of safety and for receiving race communication, including notification of OCS boats.

#### 2. Advertising

Boats may be required to display Event Advertising on the forward part of the hull.

#### 3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21, 26, 29 and 30 may compete.
- 3.2 Entries shall be submitted not later than August 9, 2019 by email to CYC, [www.cycseattle.org](http://www.cycseattle.org)
- 3.3 Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under the ISAF Eligibility Code shall be eligible to compete in this regatta.
- 3.4 For the purpose of RRS A Scoring: A competitor is not considered an entry until: (a) All fees are paid and (b) Measurement is completed.

#### 4. Fees

The entry fee of \$50 includes boat and trailer parking, launching, hauling and social events for skipper and crew. Entry fees are due at time of registration.

#### 5. Schedule

- 5.1 Registration, Measurement, Crew Weigh in at CYC
  - Friday Aug. 9 1600 – 1900
  - Saturday Aug. 10 0800 – 1000
  - Continental Breakfast at CYC
- 5.2 Schedule of Races
  - Saturday, Aug. 10 Three races scheduled.
    - 1100 First warning
    - Dinner at CYC Clubhouse following racing
  - Sunday, Aug. 11 Three races scheduled.
    - 1100 First warning
    - No Warning after 1600.
    - Awards following racing at hoist area

## 6. Measurement

- 6.1 Each participating boat shall have a valid Measurement Certificate in the name of the current owner, and Weight Certificate.
- 6.2 Crews shall demonstrate compliance with crew weight limits in accordance with STCR 31.1.3 prior to 1000 Aug. 10, 2019. Weigh in will be at the CYC clubhouse.
- 6.3 Each boat shall show the sail number and national letters as indicated on the Official Entry Form.

## 7. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

## 8. Venue

Racing will be conducted on Puget Sound in the Shilshole Bay area and areas North of Meadow Point.

## 9. Courses

Courses will be Course 4, possibly modified by the Sailing Instructions to use the Start/Finish pin as a leeward mark.

## 10. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each series score will be the total of her races scores with her worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed.

## 11. Berthing

Boats shall be berthed at the dry storage area near Corinthian Yacht Club.

## 12. Haul-out Restrictions

The Organizing Authority may impose haul-out restrictions.

## 13. Team and Private Support Boats

A yacht shall receive no outside assistance from support boats or otherwise once she has left the dock for the day until the finish of the last race of the day, except in the case of emergency and/or towing supplied by the organizer and available to all participants.

## 14. Prizes

- 14.1 Perpetual Trophies will be awarded according to STCR 24.
- 14.2 Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through third.

## 15. Disclaimer

The Organizing Authority may require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the property of Corinthian Yacht Club.. The Organizing Authority, their members, employees, officers and/or agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.

## 16. Insurance

Boats sailing in this regatta must be adequately insured against third party liability for racing risks. Proof of same may be requested.
