February 27-28 – Blake Island Marina – Enjoy the great beaches and trails for day hikes. In the evening share dinner & campfire in protection of a shelter

March 13-14 – Port Blakely Raft Up - Enjoy Port Blakely with easy shore access for hiking at the head of bay. Maybe no potluck dinner in the evening, but bring an appetizer to share.

April 3-4 (Easter)– Poulsbo at the dock Explore the shops, galleries and breweries. Socially distanced dinner, or restaurant take-out?

April 17-18 – Kingston Marina Pizza Cruise - An original classic CYC cruise. Join fellow CYC members at this popular destination. Socialize at outdoor picnic shelter on the dock.
